is hereby permitted to fish for **SANDEELS** (target species) within the area of SWSFC District subject to the following conditions:-

1. The Holder of this permit may fish from any beach within the SWSFC District with the exception of:
 - (1) Within 200 metres of any freshwater source.
 - (2) From any beach to the east of Mumbles Head, Swansea.
 - (3) Within the Burry Inlet (ie. East of a line between the Northerly point of Whiteford point drawn to Whiteford Lighthouse thence to the Barrel Post Marker off Burry Port East dock).
 - (4) Within the Three Rivers Estuary (Taf, Tywi and Gwendraeth) defined as being situated within an area west of a line drawn south from 51 degrees 43N 04 degrees 22.30W on Cefn Sidan (and marked by a post), and east of a line drawn south from the central lookout point situated centre of Pendine Sands.
 - (5) Any part of Caldey Island.
 - (6) Any part of the Milford Haven waterway eastward of a line between Chapel Bay (Angle), Stack Rock and South Hook Point.
 - (7) Within a line drawn from Castle Point to Saddle Point (Solva).
 - (8) Within a line drawn from Pen-y-Bal and Cat Rock (Newport).
2. This permit shall remain in force until **31st December 2008**
3. The permit holder must be present when the net is operated, and must have in his possession at all times, a copy of the permit.
4. The net must not be more than 40m long x 2m deep (excluding headrope length), and at least one third of that length shall have a mesh size no greater than 15mm.
5. The net may not be used between half-an-hour after sunset on any day and half-an-hour before sunrise on the following day.
6. The net is operated in a continuous fashion as a beach seine and one end of the net must be attached to the shore at all times.
7. All fish except target species must be handled carefully and returned to the sea as soon as possible.
8. Details of the operation of the net and by-catch must be kept and a catch return made to the office at the end of the year.
9. The Committee reserves the right to amend this permit at anytime and will notify the permit holder upon doing so.
10. This permit is subject to forfeiture if the above conditions are not met.
